2. No tobacco products, alcohol, drugs, firearms, fireworks, stuff for pranks, or other inappropriate items.
3. No CD players, tape players, radios, or any other personal music players unless youth minister approves.
4. Treat all adults courteously and with respect. Use your best manners and politeness: Use Sir or Ma'm, Please, and Thank You.
5. Inside jokes, whispering, criticism of others, sarcastic remarks and the like will not be tolerated.
6. Dress modestly. (No halter-tops, midriiffs showing, anything really tight, spaghetti straps, short shorts, short skirts, two piece bathing suites, cut-off shirts, etc.)
7. No inappropriate pranks or practical jokes (i.e. - jokes/pranks that cause harm to a person or property, or result in humiliation of another person).
8. No physical contact between guys and girls or any other public display of affection. No leaning on each other on the bus. When staying overnight, no guys are allowed in girls rooms or no girls allowed in guys rooms.
9. While visiting any facility, we will abide by any rules that may be in addition to those on this list.
10. The Youth Minister or any other staff member may send any student home that does not conduct himself or herself properly at their parents' expense.
